#### The Seasons




### Key vocabulary

Autumn- temperature starts to get colder Winter- the coldest time of the year. Spring- Weather starts to get warmer Summer- Warmest time of the year

Sunny- when the sun shines and it is warm. Rainy- when the weather is wet. Windy- We can see windy weather by watching things blow about. Snowy- when the water freezes and creates snow.

Day length- the number of hours it is light. Sunrise- The start of the day, beginning to get light. Sunset- The end of the day- beginning to get dark. Monsoon- strongest windy conditions- cause wet and dry seasons through the tropics.


